We will provide you with paid training so you can learn how to operate our equipment. Steel toed boots are required, all other PPE will be provided.

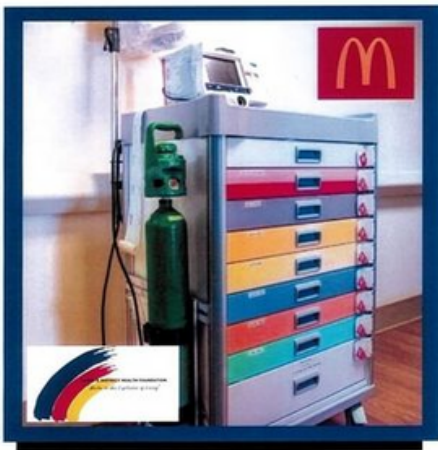
